Description	A college-level course offered in a high school context and setting for which a student receives a high school credit and may receive college credit based on outcome of AP exam**	A college course offered on a high school campus for which a student receives high school and college credit
Teachers/ Instructors	Teachers trained by College Board and in employ of the district design curriculum; syllabus vetted for content and rigor by school and College Board	University-provided/approved college professor or instructor; university works with professors to establish expectations for content and rigor
College/ University Acceptance of College Credit	**College credit awarded based on AP exam score accepted by individual colleges and universities; not determined by the College Board, the AP Program, or the high school	Accepted at public universities in South Carolina; check with individual college/university for intended major's academic requirements
