• English 4 credits

 Must have strong reading, writing, communicating, and researching components. It is strongly recommended students take two literature based units, including American, British, and World Literature.

Mathematics 4 credits

 Must include Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, and a fourth higher-level math (ex., Algebra 3, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Probability and Statistics, Discrete Mathematics, etc.)

Lab Sciences 3 credits

- Two units selected from Biology, Chemistry, or Physics; the third should have one of those three as a prerequisite.
- It's strongly recommended students desiring to pursue careers in science, mathematics, engineering or technology take one course in all four fields: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth Science.

Social Studies 3 credits

• One unit of U.S. History, a half unit of Economics, and a half unit of Government are required. World History or Geography is strongly recommended.

Fine Arts 1 credit

One unit in appreciation of, history of, or performance in one of the fine arts.

World Language 2 credits of the same language (some colleges require three credits)

A college preparatory course in Computer Science is strongly recommended. Other acceptable electives
include college preparatory courses in English; fine arts; foreign languages; social science; humanities;
